

Men's 19 European Open Championship



Our second event of the summer took place alongside the Partille Cup from the 3rd – 7th July. With a total of 98 matches being played over 5 days each team played a minimum of 8 matches with the exception of the teams ranked 1-4 who played nine games in Valhalla and Liseberg, with the final matches played out in the Liseberg Hall on the 7th July. This event had 24 national teams pitting themselves against one another for their chance to win the European Open Trophy. The 24 teams were as follows:
